## FROM THE DESK OF FR. BILLY DODGE

Some parishioners have found out that the suggested offering for a Mass intention has risen from \$10 to \$20. Before I explain the reason for the increase, let me explain what a Mass stipend is.

A Mass stipend is an offering made to a priest, in exchange for which he celebrates Mass for the intention of the donor. The stipend is not payment for the Mass itself, but rather a free-will offering that helps to support the priest and the Church. While the Mass is being said, the priest prays for the donor's special intention. The amount of the stipend does not affect the efficacy of the Mass; whether you offer \$5 or \$500, the Mass is equally effective.

So why the increase? The suggested stipend varies from one part of the country to another. For over 25 years the suggested Mass stipend has remained \$10. In recognition that \$20 is closer to the value of \$10 from decades ago, and to maintain consistency across all the dioceses of Wisconsin, it was decided to increase the suggested offering for a Mass intention to \$20. Although the suggested offering has been raised, the faithful are welcome to offer more or less than this amount, depending on their means.

The Church has strict regulations for Mass stipends. Mass stipends are recorded in a separate account which the Diocese audits. Father Sam or I may only collect one Mass stipend a day, even when we celebrate multiple Masses. The stipends for the additional Masses go into a charitable fund.


